Psalm 89:14 (NIV) Righteousness and **justice** are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.

Psalm 33:5 (NIV) The Lord loves righteousness and justice, the earth is full of his unfailing love.

Matthew 12:18 (NIV) Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will proclaim justice to the nations.

Psalm 103:6 (NIV) The Lord works righteousness and **justice** for all the oppressed.

Acts 10:34-35 (NIV) 34 Then Peter began to speak: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism 35 but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right."

1 Peter 1:17 (NIV) Since you call on a Father who judges each person's work impartially, live out your time as foreigners here in reverent fear.

Luke 11:42 (NIV) "Woe to you Pharisees, because you give God a tenth of your mint, rue and all other kinds of garden herbs, but you neglect **justice** and the love of God. You should have practiced the latter without leaving the former undone."
