**Matthew 18:1-5** "At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, 'Who, then, is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?' <sup>2</sup> He called a little child to Him and placed the child among them. <sup>3</sup> And He said: 'Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup> Therefore, whoever takes the lowly position of this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. <sup>5</sup> And whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me."
